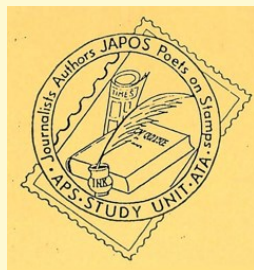

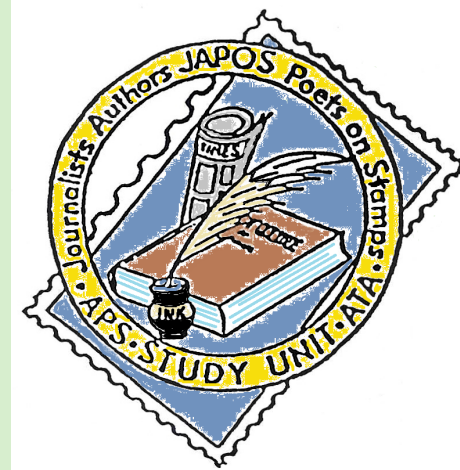
The American Philatelic Society (est. 1886), the largest stamp collecting organization in the world, has something for every collector.
